BELIEF Conference Spotlights Initiatives Fostering International Co-operation between India and Europe - EU-IndiaGrid & Euro India ICT Co-operation

EU-IndiaGrid ensures Tomorrow's innovation reaches us Today

The first European and Indian Grid-focused project **EU-IndiaGrid** (http://www.euindiagrid.eu/), Joining European and Indian Grids for e-Science Network Community, which is funded by the European Commission, Research Infrastructure Unit, has been launched in Trieste, Italy. EU-IndiaGrid bridges an existing gap by linking major Grid Infrastructures between India and Europe. The international project, comprising five European research, & industrial partners from the UK and Italy, and six Indian research and governmental institutions geographically spread across the country, specifically in Bangalore, Kolkata, Mumbai, New Delhi, and Pune, and is a landmark in scientific collaboration between the EU and India.

EU-IndiaGrid will enable a qualitative leap in the scale of joint scientific research projects between Europe and India. The project will analyse the current Grid network in India and create a strategy for interoperability - a prerequisite for the project's aim of connecting the EGEE infrastructure of Europe with the regional LCG Tier-2 centres & Garuda Grid infrastructures in India. **EU-IndiaGrid** provides support to several already existing EU-India collaborative projects in

High Energy Physics, Material Science, Bio-informatics, Earth and Atmospheric Science. The project will ensure also that new scientific areas will benefit from using the facility. **EU-IndiaGrid** will gather experts from High Energy Physics, Material Science applications, Biology and Earth/Atmospheric sciences in targeted workshops and training sessions to learn the usage of Grid infrastructure. Over its two-year lifespan, the **EU-IndiaGrid** project will bring together over 500 multidisciplinary organisations virtually on its website and through two networking events and an international conference. This human networking will aim to develop a sustained base of potential users in an 'e-Science community' - key to extending the advantages of the Grid to new scientific application areas, and thus boosting innovation in new R&D disciplines.
